Neutral Ticket Printer Linux Driver Documentation

1. Introduction

printer-driver-pos.deb is a Linux system driver installation package that supports Debian and its derivative Linux systems such as Ubuntu, Kylin, Tongxin, etc. It can be used with Neutral 58 Series and 80 Series bill printers. This document provides instructions for driver installation, uninstallation, printer driver selection, and printer parameter introduction.

2. Install Bill Driver

Linux graphical interface installation method:

Taking Ubuntu 22.04 version as an example, select the printer-driver-pos.deb installation package for the Linux operating system. Right-click the mouse and choose "Open with Other Application", then select "Software Install". In the printer-driver-pos window, click the green "Install" button. The installation is complete when the green install button turns into a red recycle bin icon.

Terminal command line installation method:

Open the terminal in the directory where the printer-driver-pos.deb installation package is located and enter the following commands:

1. Enter "ls" and press Enter to view the name of the installation package in the current directory.

2. Enter "sudo dpkg-i" followed by the package name and press Enter. For example: "sudo dpkg-i printer-driver-pos_3.13.1_all. deb" and press Enter. The message "Driver success installed!" indicates the completion of the installation step.

3. Enter "sudo dpkg-l | grep printer-driver-pos" and press Enter to search for the Neutral driver. If "printer driver for POS printers" is displayed, it indicates a successful driver installation.



3. Printer Select Driver

3.1 Automatic Printer Driver Matching

Linux graphical interface operation method:

After the driver installation is complete, connect the Neutral 58 or 80 Series bill printer. Open the printer management page. Due to the various versions of Linux, the process of opening the printer management page may differ. Depending on the actual system being used, open the printer management page. Taking Ubuntu 22.04 as an example, you can find the POS-58 or POS-80 printer in the printer list, indicating that the printer has been automatically added and matched with the corresponding driver. This confirms the successful installation of the printer driver, and you can proceed with the printing operation.



CUPS Print Management System Operation Method:

To connect the printer device, open a browser and enter the URL "localhost: 631" to access the CUPS printing management system. Select "Printers" to enter the printer devices page, where you can see the printer name, driver name, and printer status. If you have connected a Neutral 58 or 80 series bill printer that is supported by the driver, it will automatically install and match the driver (POS-58 or POS-80) upon printer connection, and you can view it on the "Printers" page.

3.2 Manually Adding a Printer and Selecting the Drive

Linux graphical interface operation method:

To connect a Neutral 58 or 80 series bill printer, depending on your system's printer management page, find the "Add Printer" button to add the printer and select the corresponding POS-58 or POS-80 driver.

CUPS Print Management System Operation Method:

Open a browser and enter the address "localhost: 631>" "Administration" and select "Add Printer" to add a printer. You can add a new printer and select the driver. In "Local Printers," select the desired printer. Enter the printer name in the "Description" field. Under "Make," select "POS" from the drop-down menu and choose the corresponding POS-58 or POS-80 printer driver. Finally, click "Add Printer" to complete the driver selection.

You can use the following functions to adjust the printer status: "Print Test Page"; "Pause Printer/Resume Printer"; "Reject Jobs/Accept Job"; "Move All Jobs"; "Cancel All Jobs".

Cut Option (Cut Option)

1. Page Cut Type (Page Cut Type): Select from "No Cut" (Do not perform cutting), "Partial Cut" (Partial Cut means Perform partial cutting), or "Full Cut" (Cut it all off). If the printer only has the "Full Cut" function, setting "Partial Cut" will have no effect, and the printer will still perform a full cut. Similarly, if the printer only has the "Partial Cut" function, setting "Full Cut" will have no effect.

2. Document Cut Type (Document Cut Type): No Cut (No Cut), Partial Cut (Perform partial cutting), Full Cut (Cut it all off).

3. Feed Cut After Job End (Feed Cut After Job End): The length of the paper left after cutting is adjustable. It can be set to "None" (None) for no extra paper, or select 1 Line-15 Line (1-15 lines) to leave as extra paper.



Cash Drawer Control (Cash Drawer Control)

1. Cash Drawer 1 (Cash Drawer 1): Not Cash Drawer 1 (Not Cash Drawer), Cash Drawer 1 Before Printing (Cash Drawer Before Printing), Cash Drawer 1 After Printing (Cash Drawer After Printing). The printer needs to be connected to the cash drawer before setting this function.

2. Cash Drawer 2 (Cash Drawer 2): Not Cash Drawer 1 (Not Cash Drawer), Cash Drawer 1 Before Printing (Cash Drawer Before Printing), Cash Drawer 1 After Printing (Cash Drawer After Printing)

Printer parameter settings can also be configured in the Linux system. Taking Ubuntu version 22.04 as an example, when encountering a preview window while printing web pages, memos, PDFs, documents, or spreadsheets, click "Print using system dialog...", then select "Advanced" in the print window to modify the default driver settings.

5. Uninstall Bill Driver

Open Terminal Command Line

Regular Delete:

1. Open the terminal command line and enter "sudo dpkg-r printer-driver-pos" followed by pressing Enter. Enter the user password when prompted to complete the removal step. The POS driver will no longer be available in the manual printer addition and printer driver modification pages of the CUPS Print Management System.



Complete Delete:

1. Open the terminal command line and enter "sudo apt-get purge printer-driver-pos" followed by pressing Enter. Enter the user password when prompted. Enter "Y" to confirm and complete the thorough removal step.

2. Enter "sudo dpkg-l | grep printer-driver-pos" and press Enter to search for the Neutral driver. If "printer driver for POS printers" is not displayed, it indicates that the driver has been successfully uninstalled, and the configuration files have also been deleted.
